

- There is an expectation that students will complete every credit hour they attempt (registered for the course and paid for it).
- Each course students withdraw from or fail to complete successfully also count towards their eligibility for financial aid and the excess hour surcharge.
- The minimum number of hours to graduate can vary by degree, but it is usually 120 semester hours. Students are allowed a small number of credit hours over the minimum to graduate, which allows interested students to pursue double majors, minors... or recover from the unexpected.
- Your academic advisor can work with you to make sure every course you take at USF will be degree applicable so that you can avoid taking (and paying for) courses you don't need!
